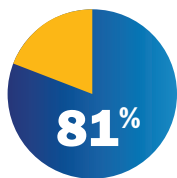

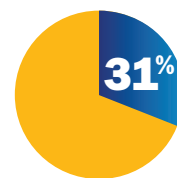
#### AGE

Six students are recipients of the Health Professions Scholarship Program (HPSP) from the U.S. Military.

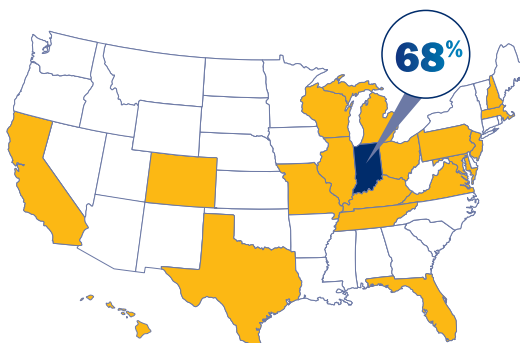


#### DIVERSITY
