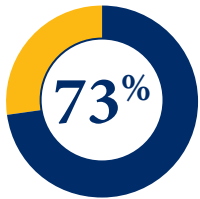

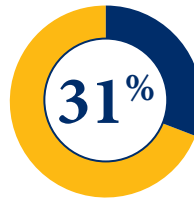
AGE

73 percent are between ages 21-24. The age range is 21-34.



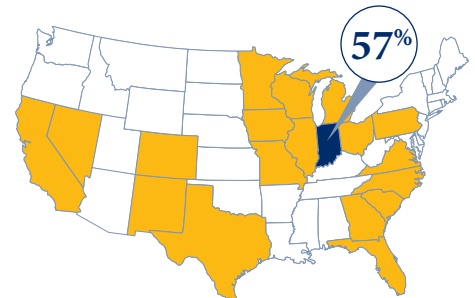
MILITARY
