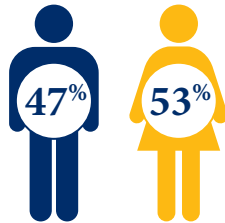

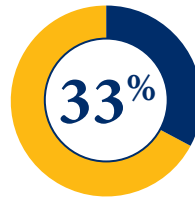
AGE

70 percent are between age 20-24. The age range is 21-37.



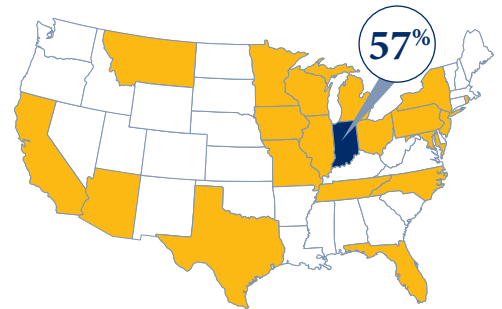
GENDER
