

2022-2023 Undergraduate (TRAD) Completer Employment Data

Description:

The Exchange is Marian University’s career and placement service. The Exchange team empowers students and alumni to explore and discern potential career paths and develop key skills critical to long-term professional success. Team members in this office survey and track all undergraduate university completers after program completion. The Exchange defines a university completer as someone who has been conferred a degree, whereas the EPP defines a completer as someone who has completed all requirements for licensure.

Degree completers are asked to indicate if they have secured full-time employment or are continuing their education to a higher level. This data is reported annually and includes completers from the academic year (summer, fall, and spring semesters).

Analysis:

- 12 of the 26 undergraduate completers responded to the survey, with an overall response rate of 46.2%.
- 10 of the 12 who responded indicated they had obtained full-time employment, for an 83.3% employment rate.
- More than half of the surveys, 14 out of 26, were not returned, which resulted in a 53.8% no-response rate.

Interpretation:

In Spring 2023, the Exchange adopted a new survey system called CORE. The change in format, coupled with recent graduates' (class of 2022-2023) unfamiliarity with the new system, led to an unanticipated decrease in overall respondents. However, future surveys are expected to stabilize response rates, with percentages returning closer to historical levels.
