

**Advanced Program Licensure Test Data – School Counseling  
2021-2023**

**Description**

The data in the table below reflects licensure pass rates and scores for individuals completing their School Counseling Program. Prior to September 1, 2021, the state used Pearson Assessment, and the EPP reported data on only candidates graduating with a degree (per CAEP standards excluding add-on licensure-only programs). After September 1, 2021, the state began using the ETS Praxis exams, and the EPP started reporting all completers, degree recipients, and licensure-only.

In the table, N represents the number of completers.
