

**Curriculum Map of Courses for Studies in Education**

The Studies in Education major completion will include 41-44 credits of combined education and education related coursework (6-7 hours of the required courses also fulfill Gen Ed requirements). 51-61 credits for the General Education requirements and the completion of a minor for a minimum total of 128 credit hours for graduation. A minor is not a requirement, but is *strongly* encouraged for career marketability.
