Peer Tutoring

Marian University's peer tutoring program is a free resource for students. Our goal is to help students develop the confidence, skills, and understanding of course concepts necessary to be successful.

The Peer Tutoring Center is located in Clare Hall room 111A. Tutoring is provided on an individual basis or in small groups. During normal semesters, students are able to "walk-in" during designated tutoring hours or they can schedule an appointment with any of our tutors if hours do not work with their schedules. In addtion to face-to-face appointments, we offer virtual tutoring appointments!

Tutoring is available for most entry-level courses, and some upper level courses. *Please note that we may be unable to guarantee a tutor for every course offered by the university.* The tutoring schedule can be found on our website:

Supplemental Instruction (SI)

Supplemental Instruction (SI) is a free resource geared to help Marian University students be successful in historically difficult courses through peer-facilitated study sessions. SI allows students to meet during regularly-scheduled times in an informal setting to compare notes, discuss course readings, and predict exam content. SI is available during the fall and spring semesters. It is recommended for students attend at least one SI session per week.
