The original Veterans Administration Hospital opened in 1932, primarily serving veterans of WW I and WW II. This historic building (Building 1) will be rejuvenated into collaborative office space for transformative educational programs, research, and services.

2 The flag pole, is an essential element for every Veterans Administration Hospital and when restored, this historic flagpole will honor our veterans and continue to inspire all who step onto the campus.

Located at the top of the Veterans Administration Hospital's grand entrance stairs, the historic grand lobby renovation will restore original features such as terrazzo risers and treads, wall sconces, and the reception desk.

The original **grand entrance**, will be transformed to it's original beauty. The staircase will lead guests up to three openings in the limestone facade of the historic structure. It will be a welcoming point for students, community members, and guests of programs from Marian University and partners. A standout feature at the top of the building, the cupola, will remain and helps to distinguish the historic structure.
