Honorary Degrees

Dr. Mercy Obeime

Doctor of Public Service

Dr. Mercy Obeime is the director for community and global health at Franciscan St. Francis Health. Born and raised in Nigeria, Obeime graduated from the University of Benin Medical School in 1988 and immigrated to the United States a year later. She completed a clinical genetics fellowship before starting a family medicine residency in 1993. Upon completion of the residency, Obeime was employed by St. Francis Medical Group in Indianapolis.

Obeime's tenure with St. Francis has been dedicated, yet varied. In 1997, she became director of a neighborhood health center devoted to caring for the uninsured and underinsured. In this capacity, Obeime blossomed into an excellent family physician, teacher, role model, mentor, and public health professional.

In April 2011, Obeime was promoted to the newly created position of director for community and global health. In this role, she works with St. Francis Health administration, physicians, and staff to expand the hospital's involvement in the health problems, issues, and concerns that transcend local and national boundaries. Meanwhile, she continues to work at the Franciscan St. Francis Neighborhood Health Center on Indianapolis' south side, and the new outpatient palliative care program, Franciscan St. Francis SYMPAQ Clinic, currently located at Garfield Park.

Sensitive to underserved families' many unique challenges, Obeime has developed a number of initiatives to help this population including: prenatal and obstetrical care, breast and cervical cancer screenings, immunization outreach, obesity and weight reduction programs, and smoking cessation classes. Further, she has developed programs to maximize social service outreach and has implemented a proactive approach to helping patients utilize and access pharmaceutical company assistance programs.

In 2003, Obeime established the Mercy Foundation, a charitable organization designed to serve the public health needs not only of our local community, but also of the people of her homeland of Nigeria. During the summer of 2010, the Mercy Foundation formally merged its healthcare outreach and education programs with The Timmy Foundation, making Mercy Medical Missions, Nigeria the Timmy Foundation's fifth international outreach program. Sister Lavonne Long, OSF '48

Doctor of Divinity

Sister Lavonne Long, a native of Rushville, Indiana, has been a member of the Sisters of St. Francis, Oldenburg, for more than 60 years, spending her entire professional career in the field of education. Sister Lavonne graduated from Marian University (then Marian College) in 1948 with a bachelor's degree in education and went on to John Carroll University to earn her master's degree in English. She later added guidance and administrative certifications from Butler University.

Sister Lavonne began her teaching career at Holy Name School in Beech Grove, Indiana in 1945. Then, after more than a decade of teaching at schools in Ohio, she began teaching English at Scecina Memorial High School on Indianapolis' east side in 1956. Scecina quickly became Sister Lavonne's passion, but in 1964 was appointed principal of the former St. Mary's Academy in Indianapolis. She returned to Scecina in 1973 and was the director of guidance until 1995. She then served as an administrative assistant until 2010 when she retired to the Motherhouse in Oldenburg.

Sister Lavonne also served on the Marian University Board of Trustees from 1995-2001.

Marian University is honored to recognize this woman who has made extraordinary contributions in educational ministry with the honorary degree of Doctor of Divinity.

Michael Simmons

Doctor of Business Administration

Michael Simmons of Punta Gorda, Florida, is principal and president of Simmons Associates. While Simmons earned a bachelor's degree in life sciences from Indiana State University in 1964, he has a four-way family connection and deep affection for Marian University, as his brother, two sisters, and a niece all graduated from the university.

Simmons is a former high school teacher who built a successful career as an IT systems engineer, marketing, and operations executive. Simmons, as a senior manager, led the overhaul of IT systems at AFNB, Fidelity Investments, Bank of America, Bank of Boston, and Security Capital Group.

Simmons' many business successes have enabled him to become a wonderful philanthropist. In 2005, Michael established The Michael Simmons Student Activities Center at his alma mater, Indiana State University. The facility is the permanent home of the Sycamore Tricycle Derby and the Tandem Bicycle Race, two of the university's time-honored traditions. Likewise, in 2010, Simmons joined longtime friends John and Pam Purdie in creating The Simmons Purdie Data Center at Marian University. The center is instrumental in supporting the university's computing needs, paving the way for a robust and intelligent technical IT platform to deliver learning.

Marian University is privileged to recognize this man who has used his business savvy to create and sustain significant institutional change with the honorary degree of Doctor of Business Administration.
