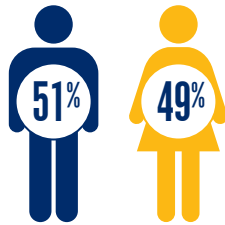

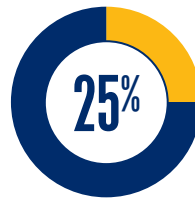
### AGE

75 percent are between age 20-24. The range is from 22-38.



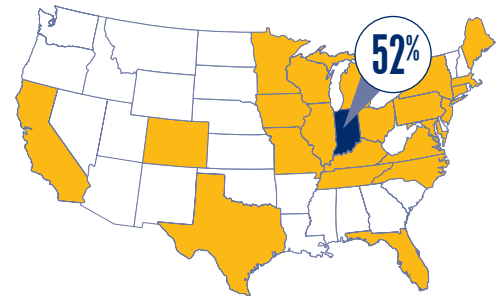
### GENDER
