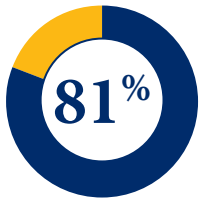

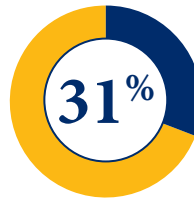
### AGE

81 percent are between ages 21-24. The age range is 21-37.



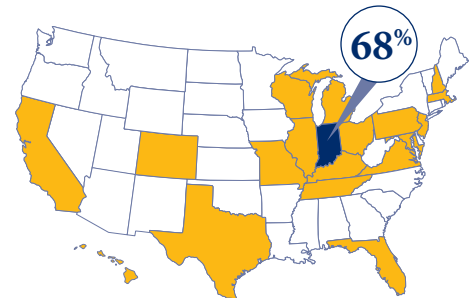
### MILITARY
