Marian University grew out of the dedication and vision of Sister Theresa Hackelmeier and the Sisters of St. Francis, Oldenburg, Indiana, who established a school in Oldenburg, Indiana, in 1851. After a number of transformations, the school became Marian College in 1936. The college moved to Indianapolis in 1937 and classes began on September 15 in Allison Mansion.

On July 1, 2009, Marian College became Marian University. On May 4, 2011, Marian University received pre-accreditation status for a new medical school. On August 24, 2011, the university broke ground on the Michael A. Evans Center for Health Sciences that houses the Marian University College of Osteopathic Medicine and the Alan and Sue Leighton School of Nursing. On August 6, 2013, Marian University held a ribbon-cutting ceremony and reception for the Michael A. Evans Center for Health Sciences. The College of Osteopathic Medicine matriculated its first class in August 2013.

## Honorary Degrees

---

### **The Honorable Mary Beth Bonaventura '76**

#### **Doctor of Arts and Humane Letters**

Judge Mary Beth Bonaventura was appointed as the director of the Indiana Department of Child Services (DCS) by Governor Mike Pence in January 2013.

Judge Bonaventura hit the ground running, developing DCS' 2013-14 strategic plan, establishing Key Performance Indicators (KPI) for the agency and presenting the plan to Governor Pence. The DCS strategic plan focuses on three broad areas: a new child support system, improved trauma informed care, and staff recruitment and retention.

Currently, Judge Bonaventura serves on the newly created Commission on Improving the Status of Children in Indiana, where her insight and experience as a Lake County Juvenile Court Judge has been valuable. In addition to the commission, Judge Bonaventura serves on the Child Services Oversight Committee.

Governor Pence stated, "Judge Bonaventura is uniquely qualified to lead the state's Department of Child Services and help to protect Hoosier children from abuse and neglect. She is a strong leader who has an impeccable reputation of integrity and compassion for children."

Just prior to being appointed to lead DCS, Judge Bonaventura served as Senior Judge of the Lake Superior Court, Juvenile Division—one of the toughest juvenile court systems in the state. She was appointed Senior Judge in 1993 by then Governor Evan Bayh after having served more than a decade as Magistrate in the Juvenile Court.

Since the start of her career in the Juvenile Court, Judge Bonaventura has been recognized for her dedication and outstanding service to children. In 2008, Governor Mitch Daniels appointed her a member of the Indiana Commission on Disproportionality in Youth Services. In 2009, she was named Chair of the Civil Rights of Children Committee for the Indiana State Bar Association and the Chief Justice appointed her as Chair of the Child Welfare Improvement Committee.

A life-long Lake County resident, Judge Bonaventura was born in East Chicago. She received her undergraduate degree from Marian College in Indianapolis and her juris doctorate degree from Northern Illinois University in DeKalb, Illinois.

Marian University is honored to award an honorary doctorate to this alumna who has employed her considerable knowledge and skills to ensure a better quality of life for families and youth in Indiana and promote a socio-cultural paradigm that fosters respect for all individuals, particularly the most vulnerable populations.

### **Vincent Charles Caponi**

#### **Doctor of Business Administration**

Vincent C. Caponi is the executive chairman of the board of St.Vincent Health and senior vice president of Ascension Health.

Caponi joined St.Vincent Health in 1998, the same year that St.Vincent and St. Joseph Hospital and Health Center in Kokomo formed St.Vincent Health. That network has since grown into one of the largest health care employers in Indiana, and is part of St. Louis-based Ascension Health, the nation's largest not-for-profit and Catholic health care system.

From September 1998 through June 2013, Caponi was the chief executive officer of St.Vincent Health where he led an integrated health care network of 22 health ministries serving 47 counties in central and southern Indiana. In addition to his responsibilities as chief executive officer, from September 2007 through June 2013, Caponi served as Ascension Health ministry market leader for the State of Indiana and, from February 2011 to April 2013, Caponi served as Ascension Health ministry market leader for the State of Wisconsin.

Caponi came to St.Vincent Health from St.Vincent's Hospital in Birmingham, Alabama, where he served as president and chief executive officer. During his tenure there, he fostered open communication among senior management, promoted decentralized decision making, and encouraged ongoing collaboration between hospital administration and medical staff. As part of his commitment to supporting community health care needs in Birmingham, Caponi helped produce a network of medical homes for the city's poor, created a primary care center with the local public hospital, and reopened St. Vincent's primary care clinic.

Caponi is a graduate of Xavier University in Cincinnati, Ohio and he has a master's degree in health care administration from Central Michigan University. He is a fellow in the American College of Healthcare Executives, and a former regent for the state of Alabama.

Marian University is honored to award an honorary doctorate to this man who has employed his many gifts and talents to improve our nation's hospital systems and health care networks, ensure the physical well-being of hundreds of thousands of individuals, and promote greater attention to the health care needs of the most vulnerable populations.

### **Anthony Joseph Kriech '75**

#### **Doctor of Science**

Anthony J. Kriech serves as the vice president of research and development for Heritage Research Group, a company under the umbrella of The Heritage Group. The Heritage Group manages a diverse set of national and international companies involved in highway construction and materials, environmental services, petroleum refining, and chemical manufacturing.

Kriech began his career at Asphalt Materials, Inc., a company under the Heritage umbrella, in 1972 through a summer internship program with Marian College (University) as a lab technician and soon became chief chemist after graduation in 1975. Since 1980, Kriech has held numerous leadership positions within the Heritage Group, and now provides oversight and guidance to Heritage Environmental Services, LLC; Asphalt Materials of China, LLC; Asphalt Materials, Inc.; and, Heritage Research Group.

Over the course of his career, Kriech has developed expertise in the areas of bitumen chemistry; pavement design; the long-term health effects of exposure to bitumen emissions; the stabilization of metals from hazardous waste; and the reclamation and recycling of hazardous and non-hazardous waste materials. His well-published research has led to the reception of numerous patents, most recently for sound barrier walls made from scrap and waste materials.

Kriech's expertise in pavement design and asphalt specifically has led to his leadership in the design of the pavement for the Indianapolis Motor Speedway and on several international pavement projects, including those in Novosibirsk, Siberia, and the Shandong Province of China. A highly respected industry voice, in 2011 Kriech was invited to participate on The International Agency for Research on Cancer review of Bitumen in Lyon, France. Kriech has most recently been asked to discuss his research and industry experience as the Keynote Speaker for the 2013 Association of Asphalt Paving Technologists Annual Meeting and as a presenter at the 246th American Chemical Society National Meeting.

Kriech received his bachelor of arts degree with a major in chemistry from Marian College in 1975. He is a member of the American Chemical Society, American Society for Testing and Materials, National Asphalt Pavement Association, Transportation Research Board, and Asphalt Institute for which he currently serves on the Health, Safety, and Environmental Committee.
