

# Marian University International Travel Grants

## Eligibility

1. Student must be in good academic standing with no probations or account holds.
2. Student must be enrolled in a credit-bearing course.
3. Student must have demonstrated financial need as determined by the Office of Financial Aid and the Office of International Student Success & Global Engagement.
4. Student must complete the Marian University International Travel Grant application by the specified deadline. This application requires students to identify the intended study abroad program.

## Selection

1. Awardees will be notified via their University email address.
2. Awards will be based on financial need, quality of application responses, rationale for participation in a particular study abroad program, program duration, overall program cost, and the availability of funds.

## Travel Grants

Not all applicants with need will receive the exact amount below as they are estimated grants only, as the awards depend on the criteria noted above.

- 2 weeks: \$500
- 3 weeks: \$750
- 4 weeks: \$1,250
- 5 weeks: \$1,500
- 6 weeks: \$1,750
- 8 weeks: \$2,000
- 14-18 weeks: \$2,500- \$7,000

## Post-Program Obligations

1. Awardees must submit a program evaluation through the Office of Study Abroad's Canvas site.
2. Awardees must write a thank you letter, including a brief reflection on what he/she/they meant and personal realizations.

\*A study abroad program is defined as an approved academic program outside the U.S. that is at minimum two weeks long.

\*All documentation required by the Office of Study Abroad must be submitted before the grant is disbursed.

\*Grants are dispersed at the beginning of each term.
