

COVID-19 Full-Tuition Scholarships for 21st Century Scholars



At Marian University, we understand many students and families have been impacted by the pandemic in a variety of ways. Scholarship Details

In an effort to support families impacted by the recent significant economic downturn, Marian University will award \$5 million dollars through **50 full-tuition scholarships to high school seniors in Indiana's 21st Century Scholars program** who enroll as freshmen during the 2020-21 academic year. Students will receive a full-tuition scholarship that is renewable over four years.

Once students have submitted an enrollment application and receive an admissions decision, qualified 21st Century Scholars will be notified by the Office of Financial Aid about their full-tuition scholarship offer and details.

Eligibility

To be considered for this scholarship, you must:

- Meet the requirements and be recognized as an eligible 21st Century Scholar by the State of Indiana. Go to scholars.in.gov for details.
- Complete the free Marian University undergraduate admission application at marian.edu/apply-now.
- Must have a minimum cumulative high school grade point average (GPA) of 3.20 on a 4.00 scale.
- File the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
