

International Student's Admission Checklist



Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT)

Complete the Marian University online application for admission at www.marian.edu/applynow.

Be sure to select "Master of Arts in Teaching (MAT)."

Submit a photocopy of your passport identity page. Will need to see the original before admissions.

Prepare a one-page résumé and upload a PDF to your online application.

Request that your official TOEFL or IELTS score, or ELS 112 Academic certificate/transcripts be sent directly to Marian University by the testing agency:

- TOEFL minimum IBT score is 69
- IELTS minimum band score is 6.0 (6.5 for the Nursing program)
- If English is your native language please submit an ACT or SAT score

Provide evidence of adequate financial support by submitting Statement of Financial Verification:

- Submit financial supporting documents showing availability of funds for cost of attendance for one year
- Official, certified bank statement from within the past six months
- Government scholarship letter if sponsored by foreign government

Two professional recommendation forms: Recommendation forms from family members will not be accepted. Each form should be mailed or emailed separately to GRadmissions@marian.edu directly from the reference.

Personal statement or essay. Type your essay within the essay section of the online application. Do not answer each as a separate question, but incorporate them into your essay.

Request an official transcript from every college or university that you have previously attended. If you transferred credits or completed a study abroad program, you must send a transcript from the institution(s) from which the credits were transferred. Official transcripts must be sent directly to GRadmissions@marian.edu, and they become the property of Marian University once they have been submitted. Transcripts CANNOT be returned to you.

IF your baccalaureate degree was earned outside the U.S, you will need to have a course by course evaluation of your transcript completed by a trusted service such as the World Education Services (www.wes.org). Original transcript must be included. Please also request an official report of your TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) score sent to GRadmissions@marian.edu.

Basic Academic Skills Proficiency

Prospective students are no longer required to earn a minimum score on the SAT, ACT, GRE, or CASA to be considered for admission into the Master of Arts in Teaching programs at Marian University.

However, prospective students must demonstrate proficiency in basic academic skills. Marian University requires you to submit one of the assessments listed below. (Applicants are not required to earn a minimum score for admission. ALL applications will be considered).

ACT • SAT • GRE • Indiana CORE Academic Skills Assessment (CASA) • Praxis I: Pre-Professional Skills Test • Earned Master's degree with Official Transcript

A background check will be required for all prospective students applying to Marian's Educators College. Students will complete the background check via INKless. Instructions are available in the application portal.

Pay a \$45 non-refundable application fee. Instructions are provided as part of the online application.

An interview is required for selected applicants.
