Description:

To be licensed in the state of Indiana, a program completer must take and pass state-mandated content and pedagogy exams for their licensure area. On September 1, 2021, the state exams changed from Pearson Assessment to ETS Praxis. The state did allow some overlap in testing windows during the transition, so scores from both exams are included. Exam scores are reported annually, comparing the EPP with the state of Indiana on: average test score, number of candidates taking each exam, and pass rates. This information is broken into two subsets: those who complete one of the EPPs graduate transition-to-teaching programs (ALT) and those who complete the 4-year undergraduate program or 5-year undergraduate and residency program (TRAD).

Analysis:

- There is only one cycle of Praxis exam data available
- Transition-to-teaching (ALT) candidates took a larger number of Praxis exams and fewer Pearson exams, while undergraduate (TRAD) candidates took more Pearson exams than Praxis exams. ALT candidates take licensure tests near the completion of their program, whereas TRAD students take them during their program as part of the "pathways" progression
- The overall pass rates for both TRAD and ALT are lower than state averages, but are showing improvement over the three year cycle.
- The passing rates are strong for content exams in special education on both assessments (Pearson=Mild Intervention, Praxis=SE:CK & Mild to Moderate) and in both programs, TRAD and ALT.
- The passing rates and score average for the PreK-12 pedagogy exams are higher in the ALT program

Interpretation:

There is little direct comparison that can be made between the Pearson and Praxis exam results. The small sample size of Praxis exam scores in the first year of state adoption make it difficult to draw immediate conclusions.
