MU Exchange Undergrad Completer Employment Data

Description:

The Exchange is Marian University's career and placement service. Staff in that office survey and track all undergraduate university completers after program completion. The Exchange defines a university completer as someone who has been conferred a degree, whereas the EPP defines a completer as someone who has completed all requirements for licensure.

Degree completers are asked to indicate if they have secured full-time employment or are continuing their education to a higher level. This data is reported annually and includes completers from the academic year (Summer, fall, and Spring semesters).

*The term "knowledge rate" defines the percent of graduates for which the university has reasonable and verifiable information concerning the graduates' postgraduation career activities.

Analysis:

- 31 of the 42 undergraduate completers responded to the survey, for an overall response rate of 74%.
- Elementary education majors are the EPP's largest group of undergraduate completers and 100% of them have full-time employment or are pursuing continuing education.
- Secondary Education majors are the only group that have less than a 100% rate of employment or continuing education (88%).

Interpretation:

There are strong rates of employment and continuing education among EPP completers. The high number of respondents who indicated "continuing education" is partially due to the number of bachelor's degree recipients who are continuing into graduate school as part of the fifth-year residency program. There are still degree completers who are unaccounted for. In 2021, the response rate was 82% and it is 74% in 2022.
