

CLINICAL ADMISSION INFORMATION

ACCELERATED BSN

Effective Spring 2017

- Applicants must first be admitted to Marian University. Upon admission, students must meet academic requirements to become a pre-nursing student.
- Students will complete application to the clinical rotation and be ranked based on the Decision Tree.
- Number of students accepted into clinical is based on availability of faculty resources and clinical sites. Admission to all programs is competitive and based on the following criteria:

DECISION TREE

Accelerated Track

Students must first meet the minimum admission requirements.

- Completed previous baccalaureate or graduate degree from an accredited college/university with a cumulative GPA of 2.80 or higher, or 3.00 earned in the last 60 credit hours which will include the science pre-requisites
- Pre-requisite science GPA of 2.80
- All science pre-requisite courses successfully completed (C+)
- Application completed in full and submitted on time
- Acceptable score on the International English Language Testing System (test applies to students identified during the university admission process)

Eligible applicants will then be ranked according to the following:

1. Wait-listed students who applied the previous semester, but who were not awarded clinical placement based on space and still meet the minimum requirements for the current semester
2. Students with the highest pre-requisite science GPA
3. Students with the highest number of required prerequisite courses taken at Marian University

Ineligible Applicants

- Applicants with one or more Marian University nursing course failures (grade less than C+ in NSG coursework)
- Applicants from other nursing programs who have failed one nursing course at another institution
- Applicants who have previously been dismissed from another nursing program
- Students who have earned a grade of less than C+ more than twice in the required science classes (BIO 214, BIO 225, BIO 226, CHE 100, or equivalent transferable courses)
