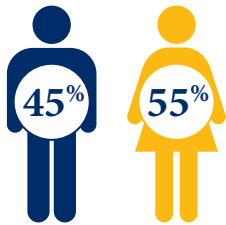

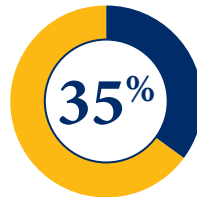

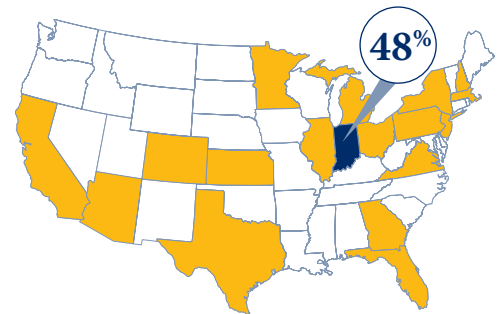
GENDER
