## **IDOE Principal Satisfaction Survey 3-Year Analysis 2021-2024**

## **Description:**

Each year, the Indiana Department of Education (IDOE) surveys completers' principals to determine their satisfaction with the preparation those completers received from their EPPs. This survey is administered with no interaction from the EPPs. It includes 21 questions covering three main areas of teacher preparation (knowledge, pedagogy, and professional disposition) and one question simply asking for the principals' general satisfaction with the preparation provided by the EPP. In addition, the table includes the aggregated state averages for the three cycles, and the final two columns show the total percentage of "Agree" and "Strongly Agree" for both the EPP and the state. The last row also includes two columns that show the combined "Satisfied" and "Very Satisfied" responses for both the EPP and the state for the general satisfaction question.

## **Analysis:**

- In the **Knowledge Preparation** of Teacher domain, 100% of principals Agreed or Strongly Agreed that the Marian completers met all four indicators of this domain in 2022-2023 and 2023-2024. Marian completers' 3-year aggregate scores are higher than the state averages in all four indicators.
- In the **Pedagogical Preparatio**n of the Teacher domain in 2023-2024, principals agreed or strongly agreed that 100% of Marian completers met seven of the ten indicators; the other three indicators were rated at 96.2%. Marian completers' 3-year average scores were 91.3% or higher in all ten indicators and earned an average score of 95.7% or higher in eight of the ten indicators.
- In the **Professional Disposition of Teacher** domain, 100% of principals Agreed or Strongly Agreed that the Marian completers met all six indicators of this domain in 2022-2023 and 2023-2024.
- In the **Professional Disposition of Teacher** domain, Marian completers have higher 3-year aggregate scores than the state averages in five of the six indicators. Marian completers' average score (95.7%) is slightly lower than the state's average score (96.9%) in "working effectively with other professionals".
- The principals' 3-year average rating of 91.3% in the "provides a rigorous learning environment" indicator (Pedagogical Preparation) is the lowest average rating across all indicators.
- Marian completers earned a 100% 3-year average rating in three areas: "adhere to the ethical requirements of the teaching profession"; "integrate technological tools as appropriate to advance student learning."; and "exhibit ethical practice expected of educators.
- In **Overall satisfaction**, principals continue giving Marian completers a higher overall satisfaction score than the statewide average in the last three cycles.

## **Interpretation:**

In the 2023-2024 academic year, principals strongly agreed that Marian completers successfully met all designated indicators, achieving an impressive rate of 96.2% or higher across all domains. Furthermore, a 100% rating on more than half of the twenty indicators (16 in 2023-2024 and 14 in 2022-2023) underscores the overall satisfaction with Marian completers' preparation.

Marian completers consistently demonstrate high ethical standards expected of educators, aligning seamlessly with Marian's commitment to instill Franciscan values (dignity of the individual, peace and justice, reconciliation, and responsible stewardship) throughout their training and professional practice.

Examining a 3-year average, with 98.6% of principals expressing satisfaction ('Satisfied' or 'Very Satisfied') with EPP completers compared to the state average of 95.4%, it is evident that the EPP effectively meets the needs of schools where completers are teaching
