

2023-2024 Undergraduate (TRAD) Completer Employment

Description:

The Exchange is Marian University’s career and placement service. The Exchange team empowers students and alumni to explore and discern potential career paths and develop key skills critical to their long-term professional success. Team members in this office survey and track all undergraduate university completers after program completion. The survey (CORE) is administered annually in April to completers of the undergraduate programs. Note: The Exchange defines a university completer as someone who has been conferred a degree, whereas the EPP defines a completer as someone who has completed all requirements for licensure.

Undergraduate degree completers are asked to indicate if they have secured full-time employment or are continuing their education to a higher level. This data is reported annually and includes completers from the academic year (summer, fall, and spring semesters).

Analysis:

- 18 of the 36 undergraduate completers responded to the survey, for an overall response rate of 50.0%
- 4 of the 18 completers who responded indicated that they had obtained full-time employment, for an 11.1% employment rate for the 36-member cohort.
- 7 of the 18 completers (19.4% of the 36 completers) who responded indicated that they would be continuing their education

Interpretation:

There was the expectation that the overall number of respondents would increase from the previous year, especially since the graduating students would have been introduced to CORE during their meeting with Exchange Team members during their final semester. Employment data was also collected on the departmental program exit survey.
