- THL280 aims to immerse students in the history and culture of Catholicism in Mexico and explore how this intersects with the indigenous cultures of Mexico. This course fulfills TJP/gen ed requirements.
- This course includes a pilgrimage to the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe, as well as visits to the Museum of Anthropology, historic Franciscan Convent San Francisco, the town of Tepotzotlan where indigenous culture intersects with Catholic mission, a faith-based orphanage and more!
