Tuition

Attendance and Participation

Students are responsible for securing the required book(s) and supplemental/lab materials for all courses before the course begins. To ensure course materials and books arrive on time, we recommend students order via the Marian University Bookstore. Failure to participate in an online course does not drop a student from the class and may result in the loss of financial aid. Non-attending and non-participating students will be charged 100% of the tuition and a grade of "F" will be recorded. Students who are reported by faculty as non-attending/non-participating may be de-registered pending verification of the non-attendance/non-participation within CANVAS and may result in a loss of financial aid. Students may still be charged 100% of the tuition and a grade of "F" recorded if the verification proves active attendance/participation.

Class Cancellations

Because many classes are contingent upon enrollment, we strongly encourage students to register as soon as possible. Unfilled classes may be canceled. Therefore, early registration enables us to confirm class offerings.
