Attendance	Book/Materials	Students must secure required books and materials before the course begins. Order via the Marian University Bookstore.
Attendance	Non-participation	Failure to participate does not drop a student from the class and may result in loss of financial aid.
Attendance	Non-attending grade	Non-attending/non-participating students will be charged 100% tuition and receive a grade of 'F'.
Class Cancellations	Enrollment-based	Many classes are contingent upon enrollment. Classes may be cancelled if unfilled. Register early to confirm offerings.
Waitlists	Class enrollment	By signing up for a waitlist for a class, students agree consent to be moved into the class if a spot opens. All drop/add actions after being moved off the waitlist and into the course are the student's responsibility.
