## Academic Regalia

---

The origin of academic regalia (gowns, hoods, and caps) dates back to the 12th century when universities began to form and most scholars belonged to religious orders. Colors became standardized in the United States in 1895 when a group of leading educators from Ivy League and New York universities (the Intercollegiate Commission) introduced an Academic Costume Code (i.e., colors identify the university and degree and the cut-and-style of the academic attire distinguishes the level of education).

### Gowns

Bachelor's gowns are simple with long, pointed sleeves and no trim. Master's gowns have oblong sleeves which are open at the wrist. Doctoral gowns are the most elaborate with front-facing velvet and three velvet bars on each billowing, bell-shaped sleeve.

### Hoods

Bachelor regalia may include a hood which is 36 inches in length. Master's and doctoral regalia include hoods that are 42 and 48 inches in length, respectively. Hoods are

lined with silk that indicate the academic color(s) of the institution. A binding trim of velvet designates the subject in which the degree is granted. The color for doctoral degrees in medicine is green; the color was chosen to represent medieval herbs. Royal blue represents the doctoral degree in philosophy (Ph.D.).

### Caps

Mortarboards are worn at all levels. Recently, tams have increasingly been adopted as the caps worn by doctoral candidates and those with doctoral degrees. When master and doctoral candidates enter the ceremony, their tassels are on the left side of their cap and they do not move the tassel. When associate and bachelor candidates enter the ceremony, their tassels are on the right side of their cap and graduation is signified symbolic when the tassel is moved to the left.

**Thomas J. Enneking, Ph.D.**

*Doctor of Education*



Dr. Thomas J. Enneking's career is marked by his exceptional leadership and engineering acumen. He began by applying his expertise to complex structural vibration projects before

transitioning to a distinguished career in academia. He spent 22 years at Tri-State University, now Trine University, building a foundation of academic excellence. He then brought his vision and experience to Marian University for over two decades, serving as provost, executive vice president and senior advisor, and finally leaving a legacy as emeritus professor of engineering.

During his tenure at Marian University, Dr. Enneking played a pivotal role in the university's significant growth, including expanding student enrollment, facilities, and academic programs. He was instrumental in developing the dual-degree engineering program with then-IUPUI and creating the E. S. Witchger School of Engineering. Dr. Enneking was a key figure in establishing the Wood College of Osteopathic Medicine, the second medical school in Indiana. He also spearheaded the development of online programs, including accelerated nursing. He has been deeply involved in Marian University's strategic planning, assessment procedures, and numerous successful accreditation reviews.

Enneking's dedication to Marian is further demonstrated by his receipt of the Snyder Watt Leadership Award, the Presidential Award for Servant Leadership, the Franciscan Values Award, and his recognition as a Founders Classic Honoree. He and his wife, Sherri, have also established two endowed funds at Marian: the Thomas J. and Sherri D. He chaired the Building Futures – Building Dreams Capital Campaign for the Steuben County Literacy Coalition and is a Steuben County Festival Choir member. Dr. Enneking has also served on the Scholarship Review Committee for the Steuben County Community Foundation and the Board of the Educate Haiti Foundation.

Dr. Enneking is proud to have earned a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering from Rose-Hulman Institute of Technology, a Master of Science in Civil Engineering from Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University, and a Doctor of Philosophy in Civil Engineering from the University of Notre Dame.
