Doctor of Public Service



Vop Osili is president of the Indianapolis City-County Council, a role in which he has served since 2018. He has been a member of the Council since 2011, when he was elected to represent a district that includes downtown Indianapolis, the city's near-west side, and the campus of Marian University.

As Council leader, Osili has partnered with faith leaders, community groups, civic organizations, and the business community to build a safer, healthier, and vibrant future for Indianapolis. Enhancing economic opportunity and investing in workforce development, he has incorporated job training and hiring of returning citizens into economic development programs, expanded access to small business financing through initiatives like the development of Indianapolis' first City-funded microloan program, and secured support and funding for innovation projects such as 16 Tech. Osili led the successful passage of property tax relief for long-time homeowners in redeveloping neighborhoods, creating incentive avenues for more affordable housing.

Born in Nigeria to an American mother and Nigerian father, Osili spent his formative years in Indianapolis, becoming an architect and leading an urban design and architecture practice with projects and offices in the U.S., Africa, and the Middle East. He is program director at Woolpert, a global architecture, engineering, and geospatial firm. Osili serves as chair of the Indiana Black Expo board of directors, is a member of the Board of Directors of Accelerating Indiana Municipalities (AIM), Downtown Indy, Monumental Marathon, and PACE, and serves on the Board of Advisors for the Children's Museum of Indianapolis and Indiana University-Indianapolis, ex-officio.

Osili received a Bachelor of Architecture degree from Carnegie Mellon University and a Master in Architecture and Urban Design degree from Columbia University. He celebrates today's distinction with his wife, Una, and their two amazing children, Arinze and Tasia.

The Fortunes have indelibly shaped the landscape of higher education through the establishment of Marian University's Penny and Jock Fortune Institute for Civic Leadership and Capitalism. This transformative initiative cultivates the next generation of visionary leaders, grounded in the principles of free enterprise and the foundational values of our nation.

Beyond their philanthropic endeavors, Jock and Penny Fortune have demonstrated an unwavering commitment to civic engagement. Penny's contributions to the Junior League, Christamore House, and the Board of Directors of the Woodstock Club reflected her dedication to community enrichment. Jock's service on the boards of Butler University and the Indiana Historical Society underscores his deep commitment to education and cultural preservation.

Jock's dedication to the arts has been recognized by the distinguished Sagamore of the Wabash award for his instrumental role in the founding of The Penrod Society.

to their commitment to preserving Marian’s legacy. Currently, they serve as co-chairs of the ambitious Journey to 2030: Always Forward strategic plan, guiding Marian’s future.

The Bechers generosity has created lasting opportunities for students by establishing the Becher Family Endowed Scholarship, supporting aspiring accountants, and the Becher/Deloitte Fund, providing vital scholarships and emergency aid to 21st Century Scholars.

Mike, a retired managing partner of Deloitte, has served Marian with distinction as a member of the Board of Trustees and as past board chair (2015-19). His expertise is invaluable to the governance, finance, institutional advancement, and audit and risk committees. Bea, a dedicated former preschool teacher, contributes her talents to the Women of Marian Society and the Friends of Riverdale and has been a key member of the Marian Gala committee.

The Bechers civic contributions extend across Central Indiana. Mike serves on the boards of First Merchants Corporation, the United Way of Central Indiana, and the Carmel Library Foundation. He also helped found Retire United, a United Way of Central Indiana program dedicated to providing educational programs and volunteer opportunities for retirees and soon-to-be retirees. Bea’s 30-plus years of service to the Conner Prairie Alliance, particularly her role at the Apple Store, exemplifies her commitment to community engagement.

Mike earned a Bachelor of Science in Accounting from the Indiana University Honors School of Business, and Bea received her Bachelor of Education from Ball State University.

Raul E. Zavaleta

Doctor of Philanthropy



Raul Zavaleta is a distinguished leader in the life sciences industry and a dedicated advocate for higher education. As a partner at Coqent Scientific, a premier scientific consulting firm serving pharmaceutical and biotechnology companies, he leverages

his extensive expertise to drive innovation and advancement. His commitment to Marian University is exemplified by his more than two decades of service as a trustee and his continued engagement as trustee emeritus. Notably, he was pivotal in the Life Sciences initiative, a visionary endeavor that established the Wood College of Osteopathic Medicine.

Zavaleta’s entrepreneurial spirit is evident in his co-founding of Covance, a pioneering laboratory specializing in clinical testing for pharmaceutical and biotechnology clinical trials. His leadership has also propelled numerous life science and software technology start-ups to rapid growth and successful acquisitions by major corporations.

His dedication to civic engagement is equally profound. He has served on the boards of esteemed organizations, including the Indianapolis Chamber of Commerce, the Indiana Health Industry Forum (now the Indiana Life Sciences Association), United Way of Central Indiana, Indiana Sports Corp., the Indianapolis Arts Council, Enlace Academy, and La Plaza, demonstrating his unwavering commitment to the advancement of the community.

Zavaleta’s contributions have been recognized with prestigious accolades, including The Indianapolis Colts Golden Horseshoe Award for Top Volunteer, the La Plaza Hispanic American Community Leader Award, and Marian University’s Snyder-Watt Leadership Award.

Zavaleta, a proud alumnus of the University of California, Los Angeles (UCLA), earned his Bachelor of Science in Chemical Engineering. His athletic prowess was also evident at UCLA, where he was a member of the men’s soccer team, earning All-American honors and serving as team captain for three years.

Today, Raul celebrates this distinction alongside his cherished wife, Debbie, with whom he will mark 45 years of marriage.
