## WORLD LANGUAGE PLACEMENT TESTING: INTERPRETING YOUR RESULTS

All bachelor degree seeking students at Marian University must have credit for one world language course to fulfill their general education requirement. Students do not receive credit for completing the placement test.

To fulfill the world language general education requirement, all students must do one of the following:

- To continue study of a language in which the student has previous experience, the student must take the world language placement test and then take the course into which they placed. Students may not take a course at a level lower than that into which they tested.
- Choose a new world language that the student has not previously studied and take the 101 (introductory) level. The placement test is not required if the student has no previous experience in the language.
- Receive alternative credit such as AP/IB credit, or dual/transfer credit taken prior to beginning the first semester at Marian University.

Students who matriculated to Marian University in fall 2024 or later who take the placement test, take the course into which they placed, and pass that course with a C or above, receive back credit according to the below chart.
